During his time at NMSU he won the title of 2008 National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association All-Around World Champion. In 2011 Wyatt won the Turquoise Circuit Team Roping Rookie of the year. We lost Wyatt too soon, but we would like for you to carry on his honesty, love for family and friends, dedication to the sport and to further your education.
