AHSRA Finals 2018 Special Events & Information

Wednesday, June 6th: Queen Contest

9:00 am: Horsemanship - Main arena at Payson Event Center.

2:00 pm: Queen Contestants have a luncheon with the judges, an interview and will model at the Quality Inn Tonto Conference Room (801 N Beeline Hwy). **Note: Contestants will give their speeches at the Event Center on 6/6. Contact the AHSRA Queen Coordinator for details.**

Thursday, June 7th: Volleyball Tournament

The tournament will be held in the warm-up arena following the competition; usually starting around 6-6:30 PM and wrapping up around 8 PM. Teams can be co-ed or otherwise. Teams of six are recommended with simultaneous play on two courts. Awards will be given to the championship team! This is a fun event; be creative!

Friday, June 8th: (Theme – Hollywood Glitz & Glam)

Location: Mazatzal Casino Mile Marker 251, State Route 87

Time: 8 pm – Midnight

Entry/Check-in: Admission is free. You MUST bring or wear your back number (serves as your ticket). You will check-in for prom with your number, which will be re-issued to you upon leaving the event. Once you leave prom you may not re-enter.

Theme: Hollywood Glitz & Glam. DJ, drinks and snacks are provided. **Attire:** Semi-formal appropriate attire.

Saturday, June 9th:

Dinner Banquet & Awards Presentation

A dinner and awards ceremony will be held at the Payson Event Center at 6 PM. Tickets are \$12 per person/per plate. Tickets are available on-line at <https://paysonparks.com/CourseActivities.aspx?id=16&cat=4>.

Please Note: This is a catered event. Dinner tickets/payments are non-refundable and only 250 total dinner tickets will be sold.

Stall Reservations: USE AT YOUR OWN RISK

Stalls are available for rent through the Town of Payson for \$10 per stall/per day. Reserve and make payment for your stall(s) on-line by Sunday, June 3rd. Stall payments are non-refundable. Stall rentals are available on-site only after the 6/3 deadline. A \$50 late fee will be assessed after May 27th.

Safety First: Absolutely no tie-outs. Stalls are available for rent or you can bring your own corrals. If renting stalls and bringing a stallion, please contact Lauren Moore at (928) 472-5112 in advance so appropriate arrangements can be made.

Stall Management: Your name will be on the quantity of stalls that you reserved/paid for. Please do not put a horse in a stall until you have paid and your name is on the stall. Shavings are not included; however, there are nearby feed & supply stores—**Pet Club:** (928) 474-4165, (101 W Aero Dr) and **Tractor Supply:** (928) 474-2829, (510 E. Highway 260).

Dry Camp/Rig Pass

There is a \$10 a day dry camp/rig fee. Please park your rig in designated areas. Dry camp/rig fees are to be paid in advance via on-line registration – deadline June 3rd. Upon arrival, you will be

given a colored pass to be made visible on your rig throughout the entire event.

AHSRA 2018 Finals Souvenir T-Shirts

T-shirts are made available to you by pre-order purchase via on-line registration. Each shirt is \$15. Please fill out the size(s) and quantity(s) you would like (see Reservation Form). There may be a limited supply of non-reserved shirts for sale, but quantities and sizes are not a guarantee. T-shirt sales are non-refundable.

Facility Improvement Fee

This is a mandatory one-time flat fee of \$5 that is added to your total payment. This fee goes toward facility improvements.

Water, Manure & Trash

Water: There are three spigots available for horse watering purposes located under the treed area just north of the horse pens. **Manure:** There is a manure dumping area located near the stalls. **Trash:** There will be multiple trash receptacles located throughout the facility along with dumpsters.

Fire Restrictions

June is our driest month. For safety measures, **campfires and use of charcoal are not allowed**; however, gas grills are allowed.

Adult Beverages & Glass Containers

The consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited at this event. Additionally, please do not bring/use beverages in glass bottle containers.

Tow Away Zones

Fire Marshal Rules indicate that vehicles are to not be parked within 50 feet of tent(s), bleachers, stalls, or behind announcer's booth. Also, do not block any roads and adhere to NO PARKING signs. Due to safety measures, violators will be towed. In case of a towed vehicle, call the Payson Police Department at (928) 474-5177 to find out which towing company has your vehicle.
