

AHSRA Prom Guidelines

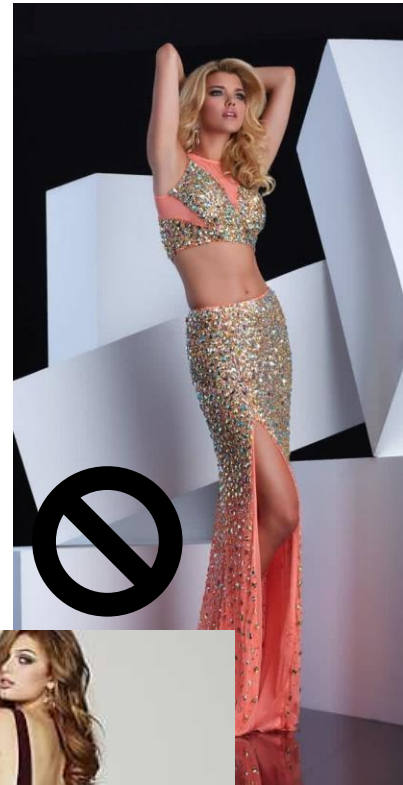
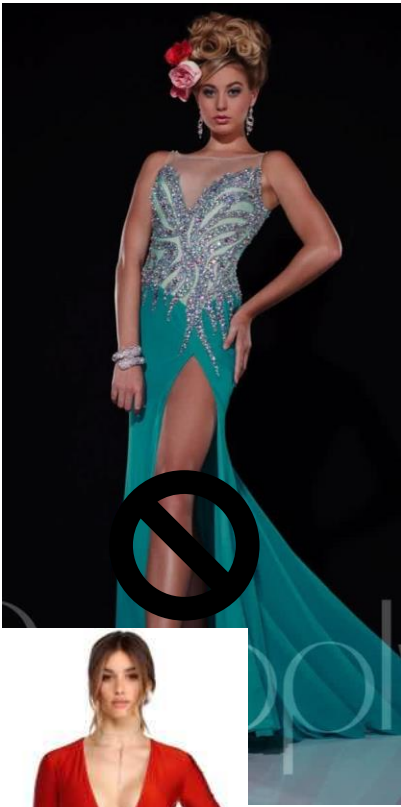
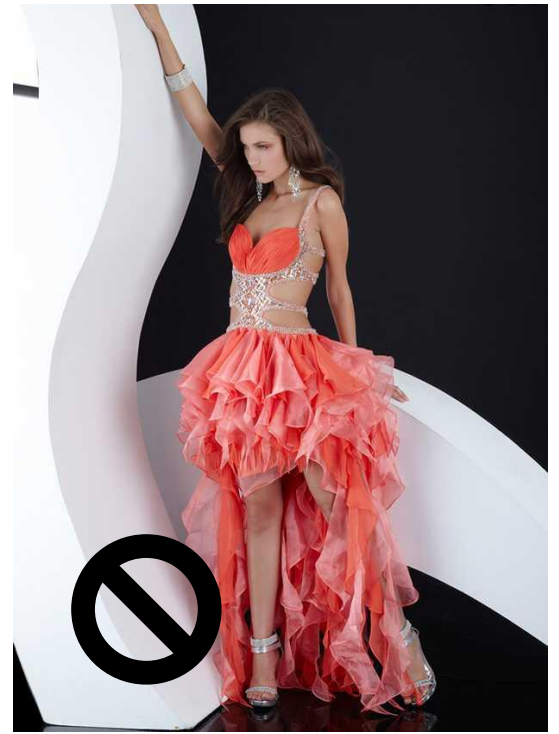
We are looking forward to a memorable night for the 2023 Arizona High School Cowboy Prom! The theme this year is “Black and White, Western Movies” We have some fun décor and surprises planned for this. Prom will be held on **Friday, June 2nd, 2023**. We have a live band planned with breaks of “DJ” music. We encourage you to learn the two-step, swing, and line dances! There will also be Blackjack Tables to play on before Prom and during the band breaks, along with raffles, and the crowning of King & Queen,

Guidelines:

- The Code of Conduct for all members and their guests will be followed per NHSRA Rulebook, especially pages 36 & 37.
- Dress Code:
 - Cowgirls
 - Formal Dress for girls
 - Dresses/skirts should maintain their length with movement. Keep the “Fingertip Rule” in mind when picking out your dress. Slits should follow this rule as well.
 - Dresses/tops should be at the bust line or higher/use your fold of the armpit as a guide.
 - The back of dresses/tops should be at the natural waistline or higher. Use the top of the belly button as a guide. **NO** completely backless dresses allowed.
 - Exposed midribs should be two inches or smaller, use the width of three fingers as a guide.
 - Footwear should be boots, formal, or good condition shoes.
 - Cowboys
 - Rodeo dress code and/or jacket and tie/vest
 - Boots or good condition shoes, cowboy hats (no ball caps)

Dance Verification

A member requesting to bring a friend who is not a member of AHSRA must have this form completed before entering the Cowboy Prom. This form requires a copy of a picture ID of the guest to be attached proving age. A member's guest cannot be over 20 years of age or a junior high/middle school student.

With the presentation of this form a current AHSRA member may provide a guest back number to the guest. For your guest to gain attendance at the dance, a back number, this form, and a picture ID of the guest must be presented at the door the evening of the dance, or the guest will not be allowed to enter!

Dance Verification Forms must be returned at least 3 days before the dance.
